

**Worship By Expecting and Following**  
**Mark 10:46-52**

1. The Blind Begger (vv. 46-48)

A. Daily Pleading. v. 46

46a. "And they came to Jericho."

46b "And as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging."

B. Disturbing the Peace. (vv. 47-48)

47a. "And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth."

47b. "He began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me."

48. "And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me."

What cultural blindness do you need to overcome for the sake of the Aarons and Bartimaeuses of your community?

2. The Merciful Master (Mark 10:49-52)

A. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 49-50)

49a. "and Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they called the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort."

49b. "Rise"

49c. "He calleth thee."

50. "And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus."

B. Jesus Makes \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 51-52)

51a. "And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee?"

51b. "The man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight."

52a. "And Jesus said unto him. Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole."

52b. "And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way."

Eventually each of us will reach the point where there is no healing for our current bodies. But are we moving daily toward the wholeness that Jesus offers us?
